

Deep Runs The Canyon

The latest documentary film from Nakusp based videographer/paddler Carl Jacks mixes artistic visionary elements with stories of local whitewater kayaking adventure. Filmed throughout the West Kootenays, the film follows the Endangered Creeks Expedition, a collective of area paddlers concerned about the offsets of Run-of-River hydroelectric projects. Documenting several exploratory ECE inspired journeys, viewers are further drawn into the film with several expressions of abstract canyon imagery. "I wanted this film to be an artistic piece as much as it documents the experience we have while kayaking these special canyons" explains Carl. Using creative and complex camera angles with documentary style story telling, this 24 minute film is bound to impress anyone who has ever been curious of the paddler's view from deep in the canyon.
